## *Scope and Contents*

This collection consists of records pertaining to the production of the T-48 Tank for the Department of the Army by the Ford Motor Co. Tank Division in Livonia Michigan from 1951-1955. The majority of the materials are contracts (#DA-20-108-ORD-11273), correspondence, and Ford Surveys and Studies and many are from John Coombe, the Government Relations Department Manager. Box 1 contains correspondence, contracts, and the Government Relations Department Mail Register (folder 12). Box 2 contains six copies of the Ford Motor Co. Tank Division Standby Storage Proposal (folder 5), contract supplements, and a visitor register for the Tank Division (folder 1). Box 3 contains a report on the fire in the Tank Plant in Livonia on Feb 29, 1952 (folder 12) which includes pictures, as well as contract schedules, reports, and correspondence, including a letter about termination of contract in folder 13. Box 4 consists of Necessity Certificates (folders 2 and 5), correspondence, reports, and schedules and supplements to contracts. Box 5 includes schedules to the contract and three Department of the Army Technical Manuals (folders 12-14). Box 6 contains 20 copies of the Mobilization Study for the T-48 Tank Production Facility contained in brown paper packages (considered folder 2), and two schedules.

## *Comment*

All rubberbands were removed from documents. Records held in three ringed binders were removed from the binders and separated into acid free folders. Five of the copies of the Mobilization Study for the T-48 Tank Production Facility were removed from their brown paper container and placed loose in the box. The brown paper container was disposed of, it only had "Books 56-60" written on it.
