## BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

PCGCampbell, formerly known as Campbell & Co., is a marketing and public relations agency located in Dearborn, Michigan. Founded in 1982, this agency provided creative services, such as photography, promotional materials and video recordings, to the Ford Motor Company. The materials generated include coverage of Ford Motorsports events, races, cars, and drivers, the Volvo Car Company, and the Ford GT production car.

The beginnings of Ford Motorsports can be traced back to October 10, 1901, when Henry Ford defeated Alexander Winton in a race at the Detroit Driving Club in Grosse Pointe, Michigan. Within 2 years, another Ford car, the 999, managed to achieve a record speed of 60 mph at the Indiana Fairgrounds track. Since that start, Ford Motorsports has continued to be a major player in the world of automobile racing around the world, with teams in stock car racing, drag racing, rally racing, and road racing.

Volvo was founded in 1927 by Assar Gabrielsson and Gustaf Larson, with the initial company producing both cars and trucks with an emphasis on durability to contend with Sweden's weather conditions and rough road surfaces. In 1999, the Volvo Car Corporation was sold to Ford Motor Company, where it joined Jaguar and Land Rover as the luxury brands of the business. Eleven years later, in 2010, Ford Motor Company sold the Volvo Car Corporation to the Zhejiang Geely Holding Group based in Hangzhou, China.

The Ford GT was a production car introduced in 2004 as the premium sports car for the company. This vehicle was inspired by the GT40 race cars that won the 24 Hours of Le Mans race between 1966 and 1969.

## SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The PCGCampbell Ford Motor Company Photographs and Motion Pictures is a wide-ranging collection of photographic prints and negatives, slides, transparencies, CD-ROMs, ephemera, presentations, films, videocassettes, and DVDs related to different aspects of the company, but with a main focus on automobile racing. The PCGCampbell Ford Motor Company Photographs and Motion Pictures is comprised of 3 series: the **FORD MOTORSPORTS SERIES**, the **VOLVO CAR COMPANY SERIES**, and the **FORD GT PRODUCTION SERIES**.

The **FORD MOTORSPORTS SERIES** (53.46 cubic ft., including 1 oversize box, 39 reels, and 323 videocassettes) is made up of 5 subseries. The **Photographs and Accompanying Materials subseries** (27.09 cubic ft.) contains 3 sub-subseries related to aspects of Ford Motor Company and automobile racing: the **Driver sub-subseries**, the **Event sub-subseries**, and the **Year sub-subseries**. The **Driver sub-subseries** (3.75 cubic ft.) contains photographic prints of drivers from the 1980s and 1990s arranged alphabetically, profiles containing photographic prints and other works arranged alphabetically, and photographic prints of Ford Motorsports Trans-Am drivers from the 1980s and 1990s.

The **Events sub-subseries** (0.50 cubic ft.) contains photographic images in several formats and other materials related to specific events: the Detroit Grand Prix, races held at Sears Point Raceway (now the Sonoma Raceway), and the Great Detroit Riverboat Race held on May 20, 1988. The albums containing the Detroit and Sears Point photographic prints are not dated, but appear to be from the mid-1980s.

The **Year sub-subseries** (22.84 cubic ft.) contains materials and photographic images in several formats, including prints, negatives, and slides, related to Ford Motorsports, drivers, race cars, and races held from the 1980s to the 2000s. This sub-subseries is arranged chronologically by year groupings (1981-1987, 1988-1990, 1991-1995, 1996-1999, 2000-2009).

The **Presentation Materials subseries** (1.00 cubic ft., including 7 zip disks, and 1 CD-ROM) contains the printed versions of slideshow presentations created in the Portable Interactive Presentation System (PIPS). Zip disks and CD-ROMs have remained with their original scripts; access may be restricted due to technical limitations.

The **Motion Pictures subseries** (24.18 cubic ft., 39 reels and 323 videocassettes) is comprised of 2 sub-subseries, **Film** and **Video**. Some of these materials are located in cold storage, and access may be restricted due to technical limitations.

The **Film sub-subseries** (6.18 cubic ft., 39 reels) contains motion pictures, and is divided into 3 main topics: Auto Show Coverage (documentation of the 1990 Detroit Auto Show); Racing Into the Future (films related to the promotional campaign of the same name); and Other Subjects (which include Sir Jackie Stewart, the Talladega 500, and races at Watkins Glen International racetrack).

The **Video sub-subseries** (18.00 cubic ft., 323 videocassettes) contains videocassettes in multiple formats, including VHS and Beta, and is organized into 7 main topics. Auto Show Coverage contains footage of the Detroit and Tokyo Auto Shows held in 1989 and 1990. The Automobile, Parts, and Testing videos relate to specific makes, models, parts, and product testing from 1986 to 1991. The Lyn St. James grouping contains recordings that document the career of driver Lyn St. James from 1988 to 1991. Motorweek Illustrated consists of copies of episodes of a television program called "Motorweek Illustrated" that aired between 1986 and 1990. In Races and Race-Related Functions, tapes are comprised of footage from specific races, as well as pre- and post-race events, from 1983 to 1993. The Dean Black Materials are videocassettes and correspondence related to tapes that Mr. Black borrowed from PCGCampbell. The Other

Subjects section contains footage of other topics, such as awards presentations, commercials, and drivers, from 1983 to 1997.

The **Newspaper Clippings subseries** (1.00 cubic ft.) contains loose newspaper clippings and bound material provided by a clipping service related to Ford Motorsports drivers and races in 1991. Articles are from newspapers from around the United States.

The **Ephemera subseries** (0.19 cubic ft.) contains one packet of earplugs and one baseball style hat from Ford Motorsports.

The **VOLVO CAR COMPANY SERIES** (1.00 cubic ft., including 19 videocassettes, 20 CD-ROMs, and 11 DVDs) is comprised of 3 subseries: **Video**, **CD-ROMs**, and **DVDs**. The **Video subseries** (0.50 cubic ft., 19 videocassettes) related to various topics, from proving grounds testing and commercials to specific vehicles, such as the XC90. The **CD-ROMs subseries** (0.25 cubic ft., 20 discs) has materials related to Rousch auto parts, media information, and a shark cage commercial from 2004, among other topics. The **DVDs subseries** (0.25 cubic ft., 11 discs) contains recordings about the SC90, the Vroom Vroom advertising campaign, and general information about Volvo automobiles.

The **FORD GT PRODUCTION SERIES** (4.30 cubic ft., including 33 CD-ROMs, 6 DVDs, and 109 videocassettes) is made up of 4 subseries. The **Photographs and Accompanying Materials subseries** (1.00 cubic ft.) includes photographic prints and negatives, contact sheets, and CD-ROMs that are associated with other included materials. The **CD-ROMs subseries** (0.22 cubic ft., 33 discs and 2 empty cases) is comprised of discs containing digital photography files as well as oral presentations given at meetings of the Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE). Some of these discs indicate that they contain images of the GT40 Mark IV car that won the 1967 24 Hours of Le Mans race. The **DVDs subseries** (0.08 cubic ft., 6 discs) includes footage of GT advertising and a GT40 home movie. The **Video subseries** (3.00 cubic ft., 109 videocassettes) contains motion pictures relating to the Ford GT and GT40, as well as Ford Motorsports and automotive production in general.
