- Copy of agreement between Ford Motor Company and United States Shipping Board pursuant to contract whereby Ford Motor Company purchased 199 vessels. This agreement is signed (original signature) by Edsel B. Ford. Agreement dated 4-29-1927
- Photostat of supplemental agreement to contract between the Ford Motor Company and the United States Shipping Board covering extension of time limit for the scrapping of the vessels purchased under the original contract (3-15-29)
