Historical Note

Charles Emil Sorensen was born in Copenhagen, Denmark in September 1881. His parents immigrated to the United States in 1885 and settled in Detroit, Michigan in 1900. Sorensen bypassed high school, becoming an apprentice pattern maker while taking drafting classes at night. In 1904, Sorensen met Henry Ford while making patterns for Ford at an engineering design firm in Detroit and accepted a position as an assistant in the Piquette Avenue pattern shop. Through an almost maniacal work ethic and the ability to translate Henry Ford's ideas into three-dimensional wood patterns, Sorensen quickly rose to become an assistant superintendent of production, first at Piquette and then the Highland Park Plant. In 1915, Sorensen assumed the position of superintendent of tractor production for the newly established Henry Ford and Son, Inc. In 1919, Sorensen returned to Ford Motor Company and assumed responsibility for production and manufacturing operations and administration at the growing Rouge River Plant. Throughout the 1920s and 1930s, Sorensen assumed greater responsibilities and control over virtually every aspect of Ford Motor Company's production of automobiles, trucks, tractors, and aircraft. In addition to overseeing production, Sorensen directed operations at Ford plants and sales branches across the United States. As a member of various boards of directors of Ford subsidiaries and associated companies, Sorensen also directed operations at foreign plants. Sorensen's crowning achievement was the Willow Run Bomber Plant in Willow Run, Michigan where he was instrumental in designing, building, staffing, and tooling an aircraft plant that would ultimately produce 8,000 B-24 Liberator bombers during World War II. Sorensen left Ford Motor Company in 1944 and moved to Willys-Overland in Toledo, Ohio, where he was president and eventually vice chairman of the board. Sorensen retired to Florida in 1953 where he lived until his death in August 1968.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The **Office Files and Personal Records subseries** consist of five subsubseries. The **Foreign Ford Companies subsubseries**, 1929-1939, 16.8 cubic ft., includes Charles Sorensen's office files and incoming and outgoing correspondence with Ford Motor Company's overseas operations in Argentina, Belgium, Canada, China, Denmark, England, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Luxembourg, Mexico, the Netherlands, Portugal, Romania, Spain, Sweden, and Turkey. The correspondence covers general manufacturing, sales, and financial operations and procedures. The material also includes annual General Manager's meeting minutes, 1934-1939.

The **Subject Files subseries**, 1915-1946, 26.2 cubic ft., includes correspondence, technical reports, financial reports, and product literature covering a wide range of subjects that interested Charles Sorensen over time. Subject material includes production branch correspondence, suppliers, non-automotive production information, tractor manufacturing at the Rouge River plant and Cork, Ireland plant, World War I and World War II war production, Northern Michigan mining and lumbering operations, Detroit, Toledo & Ironton Rail Road operations, Glass manufacturing, factory inventory reports, cost records, hydroelectric power, plant building and construction, advertising, and shipping logs.

The **Alphabetical Files subseries**, 1923-1944, 10 cubic ft., consists of correspondence arranged by name. Correspondents include Ford officials and managers in the United States and overseas, as well as outside companies and officials.

The **Cablegrams and Telegrams subseries**, 1917-1928, 1.6 cubic ft., consists of copies of incoming and outgoing cable messages that Sorensen or his staff determined to keep.

The **Charles E. Sorensen Personal records subseries**, 1915-1928, 15 cubic ft, includes personal finance material, insurance papers, contracts, receipts, banking records, correspondence, design drawings, tractor design and production, Detroit, Toledo & Ironton Rail Road operations, technical and mechanical publications and magazine reprints, and maps.
