income tax work sheets (annual monthly statements used for tax  
purposes); Agreement with Dearborn School District #7 re:  
construction of school; right of way releases (1927, 1928); Yacht  
alteration plans; order forms for opium; construction charges for  
Henry & Edsel Ford residences, etc.
