Letter from Albert Kahn to B. R. Brown...giving listing of Ford Buildings for which Albert Kahn prepared plans and specifications. Listing of older jobs designed by Albert Kahn and dates of construction. Advises Ford established architectural department under John Graham in early part of 1912. (2/3/55)

Frank Campsall letter to Mr. Brown acknowledging greeting card to Mr. Henry Ford 12/22/1944

Frank Campsall letter to Mr. Brown thanking him for his expression of sympathy extended to Mr. and Mrs. Ford at death of Edsel (6/7/1943)

Departmental Communication, signed by G. S. Anderson...to Mr. Brown... advising private car "Constitution" leaving Michigan Central Station and its schedule (Sept. 28, 1916)

Ford Motor Company organization chart as of Nov. 1, 1919

Letter signed by Edsel Ford to Mr. Brown advising how sorry he was that he was unable to see Mr. Brown before he left Company. Advises him he appreciates all the good work and effort which Mr. Brown had shown. States he regrets Mr. Brown's leaving., etc. April 10, 1933

Correspondence re: British War Mission of Mr. Brown, traveling to England on important business connected with British War Mission and H. B. M. Ministry of Munitions.... designates him as bearer of important papers and states he is carrying certain munitions of war. (Oct. 22, 1918). Correspondence with Mr. Brown while on mission, etc.

Henry Ford & Son Ltd letter signed by Sir Percival Perry advising Mr. B. R. Brown is the accredited representative of that Company traveling to and from France for purpose of investigating conditions in connection with use of agricultural implements manufactured by his farm, etc, April 27, 1918....related correspondence pertinent to this mission
