Inc., which Ford Motor Co., has in its possession (1/31/47)

of Fordson Estates be maintained in Mr. Craig's office...asks'
Mr. Miller to deliver the books to Mr. Thompson's office for delivery
to Mr. Craig (1/24/47)

Henry Ford owns most of the stock of Fordson Estates Limited, the file

at Old Broad Street has been handed the Resolution and specimen
signatures for opening bank account in name of Fordson Estates, Inc.

Fordson Estates, Inc., is being carried in Manufacturers National
Bank, etc. 8/30/46

- F. A. Thompson memo to B. J. Craig re tax problems arising out of the proposed liquidation of Fordson Estates, Inc., etc. 8/14/46
- F. A. Thompson communication to B. J. Craig re bank account credit in National City Bank of New York (England)...money representing proceeds of the sale by Fordson Estates, Inc., of the stock which it owned in Fordson Estates, Limited, England, etc. Inasmuch as all of the stock of Fordson Estates, Inc., is owned by Henry Ford and Estate of Edsel Ford...future handling of the account being assigned to Mr. Craig. 8-9-46
- F. A. Thomson communication to B. J. Craig re loan of \$490,307.77 to Fordson Estates, Ltd., by Fordson Estates, Inc., (a Michigan corp.). English company to dispose of its assets and use the proceeds to pay off its debt to the American Company. Plan for this transaction is outlined...proceeds to be held in England for the account of Fordson Estates, Inc., since British Govt., will not permit transfer of the funds to America. 2/18/46
- Lord Perry's letter to Sir Rowland Smith and Patrick Hennessy jointly re disposition and accounting data, etc., re Fordson Estates 2-6-46
- F. A. Thompson communication to B. J. Craig re Fordson Estates Ltd., (England) problems and proposed solutions, etc. April 18, 1945
- F. A. Thompson letter to Moekle requesting him to properly record various transactions of stock of Fordson Estates Inc., etc...and various account data to be duly recorded. March 1, 1940
