DESCRIPTION OF THE RECORDS

ACCESSION 18

Company Purchase Orders 1929 - 1935 4½ Feet

Records of orders placed with vendors by the Stout Metal Airplane Company for parts and materials. They are filed in numerical order with the highest number to the front of each folder. Orders were not issued in numerical sequence therefore do not follow a strict chronological order. These orders are series L #1 - 16026 and G #9800 - 98500.

Customer Purchase Orders (Plane Owners) 1929 - 1945 5½ Feet

This Purchase Order file comprises orders from Ford airplane owners for parts and services to be furnished by the Stout Metal Airplane Company, containing the purchase order, correspondence and other supporting documents. Arrangement is alphabetical by customer name. There is no consistent method of arrangement within each folder but generally the latest order is to the front of each file.

Customer Purchase Orders (Non Plane Owners) 1928 - 1932 1½ Feet

These purchase orders comprise orders for parts and services from customers other than Ford airplane owners. Arranged chronologically by year. Related documents and correspondence are filed with the purchase order.

W.B. Mayo - Subject File 1924 - 1932 5½ Feet

Records from the office of W. B. Mayo, Vice President of Stout Metal

Airplane Company and Executive Director of all aviation operations in the Ford Motor Company, 1925 - 1932. They are arranged alphabetically by subject heading. Subject headings also include, by name, companies having business transactions with the Airplane Division. Records include incoming and outgoing correspondence, memoranda, and general aviation information.

R. T. Walker - Alphabetical Name File 1928 - 1935 3½ Feet

Records from the office of R. T. Walker, Assistant to W.B. Mayo, 1925-1932. The alphabetically arranged miscellaneous and company name folders are interspersed with a few subject headings. Records include incoming and outgoing correspondence, memoranda and general information.

Service & Sales Files 1926 - 1942 12 3/4 Feet

Records from the office of G. Goin, Superintendent of Manufacturing, 1925 - 1932, Stout Metal Airplane Company, including maintenance, service, and sale of parts. The files are grouped by record type as follows:

1. Subject File

Arranged alphabetically by subject. Contain incoming and outgoing corres.

2. Customer Files

Arranged alphabetically by subject. Contain incoming and outgoing corres.

3. Alphabetical Name Files

Arranged alphabetically by name of correspondent.

4. Service Work Orders

Composed of work orders and all related records. Filed by work order

number and also by subject of order.

5. Service Bulletins

Arranged numerically by bulletin number. Nos. 1 - 26

6. Aircraft Maintenance Records

Filed numerically by airplane number. Contain records of all maintenance and repair work.

Aircraft Engineering 1927-1936 21½ Feet

Records from the office of H. A. Hicks, Chief of Design & Development, Stout Metal Airplane Company, 1925 - 1932. Files are grouped by type of record as follows:

1. Engineering Reports and Information

Arranged in two groups, a. subject, b. numerically by aircraft number. Subject reports cover all phases of engineering design and testing, i.e. landing gear and lights, static tests, float gear, material tests and proposed design. Reports by aircraft number cover design and development of component parts of each plane or type of plane, i.e. stress analyses of fuselage and wings, weights, control and other systems and static tests.

2. Subject Files

Arranged alphabetically by subject and company name headings and includes incoming and outgoing correspondence. File covers information on Department of Commerce Certification, correspondence with plane owners, vendor information and engineering development of all component parts. "Component parts" as used in this guide is defined as major sub-assemblies of the aircraft, i.e. engines, wing section, tail section, fuselage and all control and operating systems.

3. Departmental Files

Primary arrangement by department or office, i.e. Flight Section, Laboratory, Legal Department, Sales Force. Composed principally of interoffice memoranda and arranged by secondary subject headings within the primary breakdown.

4. Alphabetical Name File

Correspondence arranged in "A-Z" alphabetically, folders by name of correspondent.

5. Specifications

Specifications covering special orders from the United States Government and foreign governments are grouped by purchaser and filed by aircraft number. U. S. Army parts and aircraft specifications and technical orders are arranged numerically by specification number. Correspondence and drawings regarding specifications of parts manufactured for the Stout Metal Airplane Company are filed alphabetically by vendor name. Also included are process specifications and indexes to Ford Motor Company material specifications.

6. Charts, Drawings, Tracings, Blueprints

Stress analysis computations (on drawing linen) are unarranged and unindexed. Drawings and blueprints are of aircraft and component parts, i.e. seating arrangement, interior trim, wiring diagram, protective coating, float gear, plane design and tail wheel assembly. Also includes index to drawings and drawing check-out list.

Ford Airport

Those records from the office of L. Manning, Manager of the Ford airport servicing Ford Airlines and Stout Air Service, which were

located in W. B. Mayo's files when accessioned. Includes a subject file covering airport operations, scheduling, and flight operations. Also includes a Ford Airport Visitors Register 1927 - 37.

Aircraft Inventory & Disposition 1928 - 1937 1 Foot

Arranged numerically by plane number and consists of information regarding plane ownership, installed equipment and service rendered by the Stout Metal Airplane Company.

Construction Department Computation Undated 1 1/3 Feet

Records from the Construction Department of the Aircraft Engineering Office and consists of computations of structural analyses and wind tunnel tests on aircraft component parts. Arranged by subject of test.

Parts & Tool Catalogs Undated 1/2 Foot

Vendor catalogs listing parts prices and specifications. Filed in folders by vendor name with no further arrangement.

Invoices - Accounts Receivable 1929 - 1936 1/2 Foot

Records of customer billing for planes, parts and services from the Stout Metal Airplane Company. Arranged numerically by invoice number. The numerical sequence also follows in chronological order. The latest number and date is filed to the front of each folder.

Airplane & Airport Costs 1930 - 1932 1/3 Foot

Original and copies of estimates and operating costs of planes and airport. Unarranged.

Miscellaneous Data

Reports, tests, analyses and general engineering information not held as part of a definite file group. This heterogeneous collection of records does not lend itself to integration with any of the previously described groupings.
