

EXHIBITIONS AND WORLD'S FAIRS COLLECTION

The Exhibitions & World's Fairs Collection consists of a variety of ephemeral materials related to expositions and exhibitions. Since the mid-nineteenth century, the world's fair or exhibition has provided a forum for the introduction of new technologies and new consumer products. The world's fair or exhibition, combining entertainment with scientific, technological, and educational exhibits, has provided manufacturing and commercial interests with opportunities to promote the mass consumption of their products. The world's fair, as a promoter of consumption, has played a significant role in the growth of the consumer culture.
