SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection contains loose-leaf notebooks of Henry Ford quotations as compiled by librarian Rachel MacDonald and others in the Ford Motor Company Engineering Laboratory. The notebooks are arranged by subject. Also included are several folders of material collected by various individuals, which hold Ford references to history, free enterprise, agriculture, and Greenfield Village. Among the items is Edsel Ford's 1941 statement accepting Ford plants as union shops. The collection also includes printed material and a hand-made booklet sent to Henry Ford.
