TRAVEL LITERATURE COLLECTION
1815 - 1995

According to historian Daniel Boorstin, writing in his book *Images* (1961), Americans are "probably the most traveled people of our time, or of any time". In their travels, Americans used descriptive literature, maps, pamphlets and guidebooks, many of which were saved as mementos of pleasurable trips. The Travel Literature Collection represents the kinds of materials that came to be provided by an American travel industry virtually born in mid-19th century and grown to sophisticated maturity in the 20th.

Early 19th century travelers in the United States encountered extremely rigorous conditions and modes of travel. They walked long distances, rode horseback, paddled canoes, endured jolting stagecoaches and slow sailing ships. Many overnight accommodations were unsanitary and, of necessity, shared with strangers. Private homes or inns provided lodging and food, often of dubious quality, but offered the only respite available to travelers of that day.

Country-wide demand for good turnpikes spurred the federal government to award road building contracts to private companies which were authorized to charge for their use. As a result, toll gates appeared every four or five miles. These new roads made it possible for not only Americans but also visitors to the country to travel farther into the interior. Some of the foreign visitors wrote books or articles upon returning home, stimulating interest in the United States and documenting American life and manners in the first half of the 19th century.

The advent of the railroads, which expanded from 3000 miles of track in 1840 to over 30,000 miles by 1860, provided the fastest form of transportation up to that time. Completion of the transcontinental railroad in 1869 opened the West to travelers, while railroad companies became strong promoters of vacation journeys. Additional comforts in trains such as Pullman and dining cars, electricity and heat further popularized this mode of travel through the end of the 19th century. In this opulent era a private railroad coach became a mark of wealth well into the 1920s.

Automobiles at affordable prices, improved highways, and paid vacations for increasing numbers of workers in the United States helped establish travel as a major activity for Americans by the middle of the 20th century. The family was free to choose destination and itinerary via super highways or quaint by-ways, traveling by automobile on 85 percent of their leisure trips after the 1930s. Families in all economic circumstances were able to enjoy scenic adventures in the West, educational jaunts to historic sites in the East, or perhaps camping trips to distant lakes. Organizations such as the Lincoln Highway Association and the Automobile Association of America sponsored route signs, maps and guidebooks which directed tourists to their destinations.

Motorized bus systems, organized by mergers of small companies beginning in the 1920s, provided an economical and comfortable alternative to private vehicles. Chartered tours for groups gained steadily in popularity in ensuing years, especially since railroad passenger service in the United States continued to decline after the 1960s.

Air travel had its beginning in the 1880s when French engineer Henry Giffard built the first power-driven airship capable of being steered on a course. Soon several motorized airships were giving Europeans a taste of travel by air. Transatlantic service began in 1939, but a series of disasters to dirigibles turned travelers' attentions toward airplane service.

The first scheduled air service was available to Florida tourists in 1914, but airplanes did not become a significant mode of travel until WWII. Until then, travel by airplane was beyond the reach of most Americans other than the wealthy or business traveler. Ford Motor Co. began building tri-motor airplanes for use in passenger service in 1926, and with the addition of powerful Pratt & Whitney radial engines, the Ford Tri-Motor became the choice of the early airlines. Development of long range bombers in World War II helped advance designs for comfortable passenger aircraft. Jet aircraft service, begun in the late

1950s, fulfilled the desires of Americans to reach travel destinations quickly, allowing maximum time for rest, recreation and sight-seeing.

Tourists relied on guidebooks as early as the 17th century in order to travel as pleasantly as possible. A German publisher, Karl Baedeker, gave 19th century travelers accurate information on places to visit, hotels and restaurants, as well as general advice on how to behave in society, and to beware of pickpockets. "Baedeker" became a synonym for guidebook in Europe. Thomas Cook, pioneer English travel agent beginning in 1841, is a name familiar to modern travelers as a reliable, world-wide travel service.

Fodor's Travel Guides provide an extensive series of travel books and maps for the United States and numerous countries of Europe, Asia, South America and the Caribbean, as well as individual cities. Other popular series of guides are Mobil, Shell and Michelin. Each includes volumes on countries other than the United States. One of the most utilized sources of travel guides and maps in the United States is the American Automobile Association, with affiliates in most states. Many state tourist councils also provide complete travel guides and colorful descriptive brochures to promote tourism in their states.

The museum's Travel Literature Collection is gathered from many sources and covers the period from 1815 to the present. The collection is planned to be on-going. One of the major contributors was the American Automobile Association of Michigan whose materials are identified with the accession number 87.135.

The collection is arranged by format in alphabetical order as follows:

Brochures, Diaries, Directories, Guidebooks, Pamphlets, Road Atlases, Road Maps, Schedules, Souvenirs, Souvenir Books, and Tickets.

A paragraph explaining the arrangement used precedes each format section, since they are not all arranged alike. In general, United States materials are arranged alphabetically by state, with foreign materials of the same format following. Schedules are arranged alphabetically by mode of travel, souvenirs by type, souvenir books by state, and tickets by type. Oversize boxes are filed by format at the end of the collection. The inventory is arranged hierarchically, that is, more general headings are at the left margin and more specific headings indented to the right. A date or date range at the end of a line in the inventory indicates the existence of a folder of material for that heading.

ROAD MAPS AND ROAD ATLASES

Road Maps show all main streets or roads in a particular city, country, state, district or region. Road Atlases are bound collections of road maps. Road Maps include route maps, route books, strip maps, AAA Triptiks, photographic route maps and distance maps.

Road Atlases and Road Maps are filed alphabetically by location, then by date. United States maps are filed alphabetically by state. The category Counties & Cities within a state contains county, then city maps for that state. United States regional and then foreign maps follow those for states. United States regional maps are arranged geographically from east to west. Foreign maps are arranged alphabetically by countries and regions.

Boxes 47-55 contain smaller Road Maps that are housed in letter-size boxes in a side-to-side manner with categories separated by dividers.

Boxes 56-59 contain a group of larger size Road Maps housed in folders that are ordered from front to back in the letter size document boxes.

Box 76 (Size A) and Box 79 (Size C) contain additional Road Maps.
