The Wason Manufacturing Company in Springfield, Massachusetts, one of the subsidiaries of the J. G. Brill Co., was established as the New England division for the manufacture of steel dining cars. The Brill Company was an international builder of electric railway cars and trucks whose main office and plant were in Philadelphia, Pa.
